To protect yourself and your business!

Don't

-  Export or import products or services offered through or by Amway to or from the United States or its possessions or territories or any other country, regardless of whether or not Amway or its affiliates have established operations or are doing business in that country.
 -  Export or import products or services offered through or by Amway U.S. to or from Canada or the Dominican Republic.
 -  Sell to others who you have a reason to believe will import or export.

Why not?

- Each country has its own product registration requirements, product formulas and product label requirements that are specific or unique to that country.
- Trademark and trade name registrations must be considered for each country.
- Each country has its own import and export laws and other regulations that must be followed.
- Importing, exporting or selling to others who you have reason to believe will import or export can put Amway and IBOs in jeopardy, in both countries.
- Importing or exporting products hurts all IBOs.
